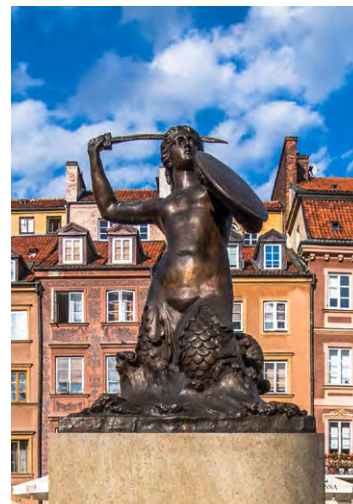

Warsaw – a historical city



Warsaw has a diverse and turbulent history. Approximately 90% of the city was destroyed during World War II.

After the conflict, great efforts were made to thoroughly reconstruct the old town, as a result of which, it was listed as a UNESCO World Heritage city. The Old Town is also the starting point of the Royal Route, an avenue that runs from the Royal Castle – the seat of Polish Kings, past the Royal Łazienki Park – a Palace garden complex – and down to the Wilanów Royal Palace. During the rule of communism, socialism influenced the city architecture, making city grey, dull and sad. However, the last 25 years have seen huge improvements and rapid change throughout Warsaw. Now it is an inspiring place, creative and modern. ■

Chopin and His Europe International Music Festival

Chopin and His Europe International Music Festival is a major attraction for classical and contemporary music lovers alike.

Organised every August since 2005 by the Fryderyk Chopin Institute, each edition follows a different master theme. Performers include outstanding Polish and international artists.



Since 1927, the most gifted piano players have been arriving in Warsaw from all over the world every five years to participate in the [Fryderyk Chopin International Piano Competition](#). The event was first designed and organised by Jerzy Żurawlew – an eminent pianist and teacher, whose intent was to popularise the music of the great composer. The competition enjoys continued interest – which is no surprise, given the event's prestige and the international careers enjoyed by the winners.

Warsaw – City of Chopin

Composer and pianist Fryderyk Chopin is known the world over. Fewer people are aware that Warsaw is the city of Chopin and it held a special place in the **composer's heart** (and in fact the composer's heart holds a special place in the city, having been brought back after his death). It was in the capital city that the Chopin family settled shortly after Fryderyk's birth; it was also here that the artist spent the first half of his 39 years. **Fryderyk's magnificent musical career began in Warsaw**: here he learned to play the piano, charmed aristocrats with concert performances, and piqued the interest of the city's press. At the same time, he led the life of a typical Warsaw boy, walking round such streets as Krakowskie Przedmieście and Miodowa, learning foreign languages, dating girls, and spending time with his friends at fashionable cafes.

While walking the streets of Warsaw, there are many places where you can find **traces of Fryderyk Chopin's presence**. Use our free mobile applications and website to find out how interesting Warsaw was, and still is! His music is considered the essential representation of the Polish nation's passionate nature, its unique culture, and the country's turbulent history.

You can visit the **modern and interactive Fryderyk Chopin Museum**, which has the largest collection of the composer's memorabilia in the world.

Throughout the summer months you can enjoy **public concerts held in the Royal Łazienki Park**, or you can have a rest on one of the various multimedia **Chopin benches** and listen to his music while you are exploring the composer's picturesque city. Just a short trip away from Warsaw, you can add to your Chopin experience by visiting the nearby cities of **Zelazowa Wola – the place of birth** and Sanniki, where you can discover more about Chopin and the typical Mazovian folk culture that influenced his work. ■

The Fryderyk Chopin Museum at the Ostrogski Palace is one of the most modern biographical museums in Europe. The museum's multimedia exhibition expertly displays the world's richest and most varied collection of Chopin memorabilia – both as an individual and as a composer. The collection includes manuscripts and printed copies of Chopin's works, his correspondence, autographs, notes, personal items, and pianos.



Don't miss!

Open-air concerts are held at the feet of the monument to Fryderyk Chopin every Sunday from May until September. The concerts welcome outstanding pianists from all over the world and are free of charge. All you need to do is sit on the grass and listen to the wonderful music.



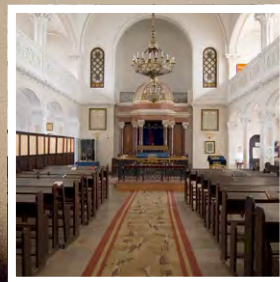

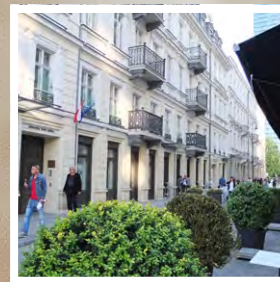

Before World War II, over 30 per cent of Warsaw's population was Jewish. Warsaw was just behind New York as having the largest Jewish population in the world. There were many Jewish schools, libraries, theatres and sports clubs. Warsaw was home to the author and Nobel Prize winner, Isaac Bashevis Singer, the pianist and composer Władysław Szpilman – known from the film “[The Pianist](#)”, and the outstanding actress Ida Kamińska.

The war changed all that, with the Nazi establishing a [Jewish ghetto](#) and exterminated the inhabitants and destroyed synagogues. In Warsaw you can find a lot of places that do not allow to forget about this tragic history: The Monument of the Ghetto Heroes next to [POLIN Museum](#), the monument of Umschlagplatz, the place from where transports of Jews were directed to the Treblinka death camp, and the sign of the ghetto wall on the pavements. In [Zabinski Villa](#) you can hear the story of Warsaw's Zoo director and his wife, and their heroic work in saving Jewish people life.

POLIN Museum, the Jewish Theatre, Grzybowski Square, Próżna Street and the Nożyk Synagogue are the places most associated with Jewish culture today.

Every autumn there is also a [festival of Jewish culture](#) – ‘Singer's Warsaw’ – which shows off the richness of Jewish culture and harks back to a former time. ■

POLIN Museum of the History of Polish Jews

- The best European museum of 2016, awarded by EMYA.
- It is not a Holocaust Museum, this is museum of life – 1000 years of history of the Polish and Jewish nations.
- Located in a very symbolic place, next to Ghetto Heros Monument in the district of the ghetto during World War II.
- The amazing reconstruction of the wooden Gwozdziec synagogue is a must see.

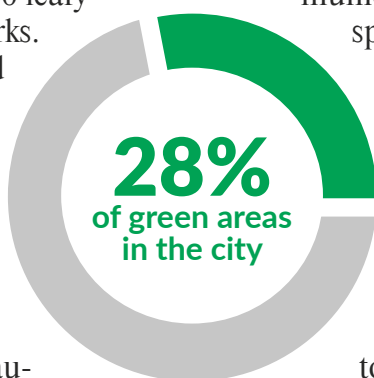

Warsaw is a salubrious and refreshing destination, because a quarter of the city is made up of green areas. There are 160 leafy squares and 95 parks. The biggest and most beautiful of these is the Royal Łazienki Park and Palace complex consisting of 187 acres of parkland in the middle of the city and beautiful architecture.



You can rest on the amazing green roof of the University Library, one of the largest in Europe with a view out over the Vistula River and the National Stadium.

The banks of the Vistula River are considered to be the summer centre of the city. This is a place where you can relax on one of five municipal beaches, rent sports equipment, go on a bicycle tour along the river or take a cruise on traditional wooden boats. From May to September, there is also a free shore to shore ferry available. Nearby, in the vicinity of the Royal Castle, there is the Multimedia Fountain Park.

This is also a place of many cultural events, such as Wianki (the summer solstice celebration) in

June and the Feast of the Vistula in September. The Vistula River in Warsaw is particularly unique due to its natural values. The right bank of the river is entirely wild and home to beavers, terns and even moose, which you might catch a glimpse of if you're lucky. The area is protected by the Natura 2000 programme. ■

Warsaw Street Art

Formerly referred to as the ‘works’ of vandals, ruining the appearance of buildings, today murals are frequently made to order, as part of festivals and at the initiative of various groups of artists, creating the street art and becoming a part of the Warsaw landscape. They are colourful, interesting and often provocative. Their subjects are varied – from historical ones, commemorating events like the Warsaw Uprising or famous Warsaw citizens – Fryderyk Chopin, Maria Skłodowska-Curie, to those dedicated to the general public, being a voice of support for crucial ideas, or honour important for world people like the David Bowie mural. ■



Culinary

Present on most Varsovian dining tables is pork, but there is no shortage of beef, poultry and fish. In Polish cuisine, **soups** play very important role. You can try a different kind every day.

Varsovians have a sweet tooth and enjoy their cakes: cheesecakes, apple pies, poppy-seed cakes and gingerbread, and during Easter – frosting-covered yeast cakes. An obligatory addition to every Easter meal are “mazurki” – a confection entirely unknown outside of Poland. When it comes to stronger liquor, the widely preferred choice is **Polish vodka**. It is served in small shot glasses and should be chilled beforehand. According to tradition the vodka shots should be swallowed in one go. In Warsaw you will find a galaxy of restaurants and variety of cuisines. We can recommend a few that serve Polish dishes:

Smaki Warszawy

An elegant restaurant that offers dishes from Polish cuisine, especially specialties from pre- and post-war Warsaw. **Smaki Warszawy**, ul. Żurawia 47/49, www.smakiwarszawy.pl

Piąta Ćwiartka

The dishes served in Piąta Ćwiartka used to be present in the Polish cuisine in the past and today they are almost forgotten. This restaurant is restoring their magnificence. **Zamek Królewski**, Plac Zamkowy 4, www.kregliccy.pl

Warszawa Wschodnia

Bistro Warszawa

Located at the heart of the Old Town, it is the winner of the Golden Fork in the “Warsaw from the inside” competition. Apart from delicious dishes, there is also

live music every Thursday, Friday and Saturday. **Rynek Starego Miasta 1/3**, bistrowarszawa.pl

AleGloria Restaurant

In the very heart of the city, strawberry bushes are in bloom and white geese have flown in. The new venture shows Polish cuisine in a different dimension. Chocolate Cafe Old-Fashioned Shop 1851

This address of the cafe and shop has been unchanged since 1894, though the Wedel factory and first flagship store appeared in 1851. Old-Fashioned Shop serves Wedel breakfasts, which consist of excellent bread, cheese, freshly-squeezed juice, tea, coffee and of course cups of chocolate. **Staroświecki Sklep**, ul. Worth Exploring

Warsaw has changed so much in recent years, modernising and up-dating the city. However, it has not lost all of its quirkiness and there are still many cult places to discover. Some of these places are reflections and reconstructions of everyday life in the post-war communism of the Polish People Republic (PRL). Others are the renovations breathing new life into old factories and halls, or the way old buildings are being used in new exciting ways. See what makes Warsaw special!

Warsaw's Neons



Warsaw's streets once glittered with neon lights – almost every building had one during the great cold war 'neonisation' campaign. Now you can visit the **Neon Museum**. The museum documents and protects post-war neon advertising, which previously constituted an integral part of the architecture, flooding the streets of Polish cities with light and colour.

The museum's collection is contained within one of Poland's old-

est post-industrial factory buildings, and located in the grounds of the cultural heart of the capital, **Soho Factory** – giving the venue an atmosphere like no other. A unique and stunning backdrop for product launches, fashion shoots, corporate functions and cultural excursions alike.

The Poster Museum

Polish posters are considered to be conceptual masterpieces and beautiful works of art. in their own right. **The Poster Museum at Wilanów** is the oldest such museum in the world. The collections extend to 36,000 Polish Posters and nearly 25,000

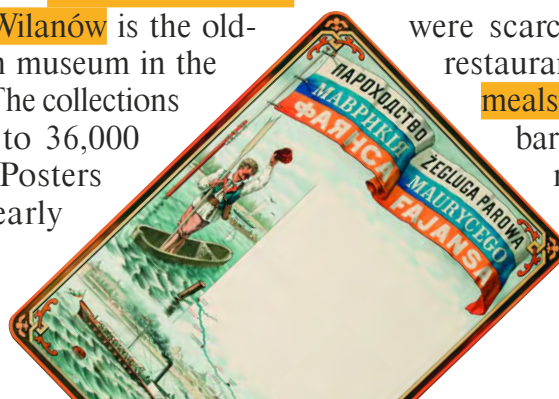
Foreign Posters. And for classic posters in a different setting, try the **Relaks café** in the Mokotów district, with its walls covered with posters in rotating displays, combining past masters with upcoming talent.

Milk bars

A visit to a milk bar (bar mleczny) is an essential Polish sightseeing experience and a step into the past when meat and fresh vegetables were scarce and state-run restaurants served **cheap meals**. Nowadays milk bars offer a wider variety of foods, but the basic concept remains:



cheap, cafeteria-style establishments that offer comfort foods – soups, **pierogi (dumplings)** as well as a meat-and-potatoes menu (quite literally). There are a few left in the capital and are not only an inexpensive meal, but with the right attitude they are also a fun cultural adventure.

Ząbkowska Street



Ząbkowska Street in the Praga-Północ district is **one of Warsaw's oldest streets**, dating back to the 1900s when that side of the river was just developing. Pre-WWI it was mainly a Jewish area with upper middle class traders and entrepreneurs adding to the bustling street life, with the street already known as an entertaining place. Today, Ząbkowska Street retains that reputation, with many restaurants and bars attracting tourists, students and hipsters. Most of these places offer Polish and Czech specialities at reasonable low price and a trendier atmosphere than some other districts of Warsaw. Praga is enjoying a cultural resurgence and Ząbkowska Street is certainly a part of that, as an **artist hub** where many musicians and painters are still looking for inspiration.

Warsaw's Halls

Trade centres aimed to bring Warsaw's open air markets inside, to be better organised and more hygienic. Now, with the abundance of modern supermarkets, they are changing again to live a new lease of life. In Warsaw there are two main halls, each with historical aspects.

Koszyki

The 'Koszyki' market hall has come to be known as the 'People's bazaar'. It reopened in the autumn of 2016, reinvented as **Warsaw's social and culinary centre**. There are a broad range of culinary delights from around the world on offer, and a large central bar, along with high quality shops displaying fresh products to prepare something at home. Hala Koszyki is Warsaw's answer to similar such investments in places like New York, London, Lisbon and Florence, bustling with activity around and buzzing with interesting chatter.

Hala Mirowska

Hala Mirowska has been among the **largest and most vibrant trade centres in Warsaw** for over a century. Rebuilt after the war, it offered all sorts of products there, including a colourful **flower market**, and was home to the well-known Pewex and resale shops, offering goods that could not be found elsewhere. Now it is a place beloved by chefs and foodies as you can find almost everything there, if you just know where to look.

Fotoplastikon

For time travel enthusiasts, the Warsaw Fotoplastikon is the place to visit! Built in the early 20th century, it is the **only one in Poland** – and one of very few in the world – that is still in perfect working condition. It allows viewers to watch changing three-dimensional images. Its archives have over 3000 original photographs from Warsaw and around the globe.

This is an alternative department store in a former censorship office during the Communist era. Housing a curated crop of Polish and international brands across five floors. You are welcome to browse through the cut-out dresses and oversize blazers, check out the latest offers in the interior **design store**, pick out a piece of delicate handmade jewellery, visit a photo exhibition... or just have a coffee in the back yard cafeteria.

By plane

Warsaw is a convenient location in terms of air travel and has direct flight connections to 4 continents, 65 countries and 179 cities.

2 international airports:

- Chopin Airport – the main airport, about 10 km from the city centre.
- Warsaw Modlin Airport – located around 35 km north-west from the city centre*.

By train

Warsaw is also well connected to other European cities by rail. There are **3 train stations** in Warsaw providing international and intercity train services. They are well connected to the public transportation network.



Visa regulations

Poland is in the **Schengen zone**. Visitors from non-EU countries must hold a passport valid for at least three months beyond the length of stay. Participants requiring a visa should apply immediately to a consular office or a diplomatic mission of the Republic of Poland in their country in order to avoid a delayed arrival to the event. Please note that the visa application procedure can take up to two weeks.



Getting around

If you are moving around the Old Town and the area of the Palace of Culture and Science, you might find it more convenient and scenic to walk. Otherwise, Warsaw boasts a quick, safe and efficient public transport system of **metro, trams, buses and night buses**.



back in time to the 1950s, you can take a ride on the **historic "T" tram line**. For more quiet souls and water-lovers, the city has prepared trips on the Vistula River via **watertram** or ferry. Finally, there is the option of taking a **rickshaw** around the Krakowskie Przedmieście area. ■

Rent a bike!

With the Warsaw bike rental system, Veturilo, available from March until November, it is also possible to travel around the city by bike. The past year marked an absolute record in the city bike's popularity. Already as many as 370,000 people have accounts in the Warsaw system. Since the system started to function, the city bikes have been rented a record-breaking six million times. Warsaw's Veturilo public bike system is one of the largest and one of the most popular systems in Europe.

Warsaw

– the main venue for meetings

Every year, Warsaw hosts about **25,000 business events** (congresses, conferences, fairs, incentives, meetings). The city is the undisputed leader in terms of the number of business and scientific events held in Poland. Of all the Polish cities, Warsaw has the highest rank in the International Congress and Convention Association (ICCA) ratings. This guide presents a selection of **91 of the most important conference and event venues** in Warsaw. This includes: 19 congress venues, 31 hotels with conference capabilities and 41 other types of venue (museums, theatres, and university conference rooms). From the perspective of the meeting industry, Warsaw offers the best range of hotels for conference requirements – **over 26,000 beds in classified hotels, and over 12,000 beds in four and five star hotels**. Warsaw offers over 179 flight connections to 65 countries around the world. The city's two airports handle nearly half the passenger traffic in Poland. The highest number of companies providing conference catering services is also located in the capital. ■

Warsaw has the advantage of having the highest number of four and five-star hotels. The majority represent international hotel chains, such as Accor, Best Western, Carlson Rezidor, Hilton, InterContinental, Marriott and Starwood, as well as others of interest that represent Polish hotel groups. Most of the hotels are located in the city centre, and many of them are within walking distance of each other. ■

The building of the museum is already making a huge impression – a fantastic, slightly rough structure that is full of symbolic Polish Jewish historical meaning. It was designed by Finnish architect Rainer Mahlamäki, whose remarkable, visionary design was awarded the Chicago Athenaeum International Architecture Award, the Eurobuild Award in the 2013 POLIN Museum of the History of Polish Jews was awarded the prestigious European Museum of the Year Award (EMYA) 2016.

POLIN Conference Centre is part of POLIN Museum of the History of Polish Jews and consists of an auditorium, conference rooms, workshop rooms, a foyer that can serve as exhibition space, and the main hall – an ideal place for organising banquets. It is equipped with an elaborate audio system and professional stage lighting, making it possible to hold conferences, film screenings and concerts there.

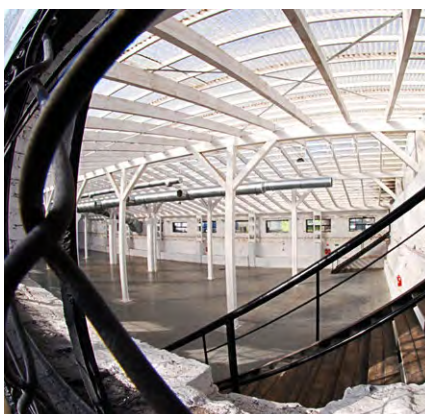

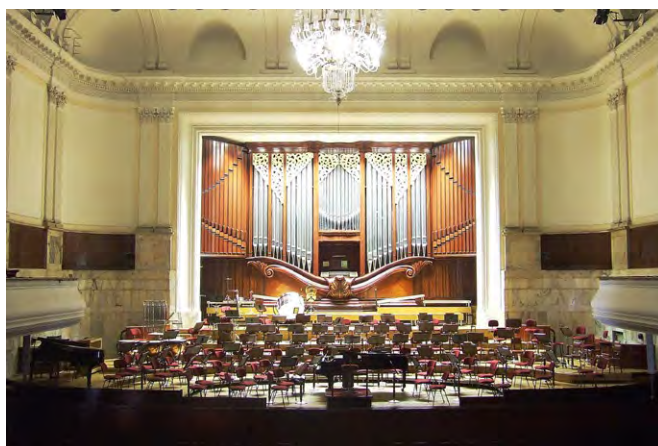

Reduta Banku Polskiego is a unique place in Warsaw. The building was designed at the beginning of 19th century by the rector of the Academy of Fine Arts in St. Petersburg – Professor Leontij Nikolaevich Benois. It was built between 1907 and 1911 for the Russian State Bank, on the site of the demolished mint of the last Polish king, August Poniatowski.

EXTENSION

The next stage of construction of metro **line M2** is its extension adding six new stations: three in the western direction and three in the eastern-north direction. The whole western section is located in the Wola district, and the north-eastern section runs through the Praga and Targówek districts. The 1st stage of the western and eastern – north section is carried out by two independent construction works contractors.
