5. VISIT TO ROYAL ŁAZIENKI PARK

The last king of Poland, Stanislav August Poniatowski, has built his residence in a classical garden in the then suburbs of Warsaw. There, he delved into philosophy, literature and art, and met the finest Polish minds of his time. The visitors will see the Palace on Isle, the king's amphitheatre and the Old Orangery, now an art gallery. The Orangery hides a treasure – the only remaining fully wooden theatre hall in this part of Europe, decorated with exceptional paintings and sculptures.

Belvedere Restaurant is one of the most beautiful and most interesting points on the culinary map of Poland. It is located in the building of the New Orangery in the Royal Łazienki Park. 8. NIGHTLIFE IN WARSAW



1. VISIT IN THE MUSEUM OF KING JAN III SOBIESKI IN WILANÓW

The Palace is one of the most beautiful monuments of the Polish Baroque architecture, a museum of interiors and a collection of European and Oriental art. Built in the second half of the 17th century, the Palace initially served as a summer Royal residence of one of the greatest Polish monarchs – King John III.

2. RIVER CRUISE ALONG THE VISTULA RIVER

A luxurious boat will take you on a water journey down the Vistula River, back into the city centre. Watch the right river bank, a nature reserve in the middle of the city and enjoy yourself.
