In the middle of the Old Town Market Square you will find a statue of the famous Warsaw Mermaid, surrounded by coulourful facades of tenement houses. Legend has it, one of their cellars was once inhabited by Basilisk – a dragon which could turn everyone he looked at into stone. Museum of Warsaw, located in one of the houses, is a great place to discover the city's history. A famous Polish Nobel Prize winner – Maria Skłodowska-Curie was born and lived in the Old Town – her house has been turned into a museum – well worth a visit. Next you can visit the Museum Wolrd of Illusion and learn how our own brain can play tricks on us! The exhibits on display will certainly boost the kids' creativity and get them engaged in the optical illusions.

Vistula is Poland's longest river. Its banks hide many great spots, such as a playground on the beach near the PGE Narodowy National Stadium. From the boat's sun deck you'll have great views of the Old Town and the city's bridges. After the cruise it's time for the incredible laser and music show at the Multemedia Fountain Park – available at weekends from May to September.
