

Trace the story of Warsaw's Jewish community by visiting the Ghetto Wall, the Nożyk Synagogue, the Jewish Cemetery and the Museum of the History of Polish Jews POLIN, located at the heart of what was once the Jewish district, next to the Monument of the Ghetto Heroes. See some of the locations from the movie The Pianist. look around Grzybowski Square and Próżna Street, where there are several buildings that survived the war, and enjoy a traditional Jewish meal in one of the nearby restaurants. The Footbridge of Memory, an illuminated installation over Chłodna Street, is also a must-see. Located in the place where a wooden footbridge used to connect the large and small ghettos, this memorial commemorates those tragic events through the use of multimedia and 3D pictures in special viewing windows.





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
