## **Communism tours**

After World War II. Warsaw architects were given the task of rebuilding the city in a new design style which was to be "socialist in content and national in form". Discover the architectural heritage of socialist realism in Warsaw with a visit to the Palace of Culture and Science which was given by Stalin as a gift from the Soviet Union to the Polish nation. Walk around Parade Square, built to host the propaganda-filled speeches of the leaders of the Polish People's Republic, and then go to the Marszałkowska Housing District to explore Constitution Square with its impressive sculptures from the 1950s. To feel the spirit of those bygone days, pop into one of the last remaining milk bars, fast food canteens from that time, for some inexpensive, home-style, traditional Polish cooking. It's a great opportunity to feel the unique atmosphere of places where time appears to have stood still.





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
